

I support fully the well founded Comment submitted by The American Radio Relay League concerning Docket ET 03-104. I think the proponents of Broadband over Power Line (BPL) have little if any credible scientific data to support approval of this docket at this time. Much more study and innovations in BPL will be needed to avoid the great risk this innovative technology will not cause irreparable interference to services licensed to operate in the 2 MHz - 80 MHz frequency range. If ET 03-104 is allowed to become law it would violate the existing FCC rules on non-interference and would be contrary to the best interest of the public.
