

I have reviewed the literature and listened to audio samples of the interference caused by Broadband over Power Line (BPL) and it is evident that this technology requires further research and development before being deployed. In its current form, interference from BPL will severely disrupt services operating in the 2 - 80 Mhz frequency range. It would be irresponsible for the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to approve a technology in the prototype stage of development that would cause such severe interference to other services. Approval of ET 03-104 would violate the existing FCC rules on non-interference and would be contrary to the best interest of the public. Therefore I fully support the comments submitted by The American Radio Relay League concerning Docket ET 03-104.
