

The Broadband over Power Line (BPL) proposal is ill-conceived. BPL will generate radio frequency interference (RFI) to other licensed services in the 2 MHz - 80 MHz frequency range. Proponents of BPL don't have, in my view, credible scientific data which would warrant approval of this docket. On the other hand licensed services have years of practical experience dealing with RFI harmful to their operations generated through power lines. Approval of ET 03-104 would not be in the public interest and would appear to violate FCC rules regarding non-interference with licensed services. I endorse comments made by the American Radio Relay League on this docket.
