

As an amateur radio operator (call sign N9NCU), I am very concerned that Broadcast over Power Lines has not been adequately researched to assure that widespread interference will not be generated for all radio services operating in the HF frequency range. This would not be in the best interest of the United States, and could severely hamper normal and emergency communications means. The FCC should deny BPL until adequate assurances have been demonstrated that widespread communications interference will not be generated.
