

The information that I have seen/heard on BPL suggests that widespread BPL rollout would have a crippling effect on existing licensed spectrum use, including Amateur Radio's HF bands. BPL proponents have suggested that this is not the case, and have tried to put the burden of proof on the existing services to show interference.

[www.arrl.org](http://www.arrl.org) shows documentation of the interference, thus I suggest the burden of proof be back on the BPL proponents. It is not reasonable for BPL to destroy the utility of existing licensed spectrum, and I feel strongly that BPL advocates should be required to demonstrate that the level of interference they would create is within acceptable levels permitting existing use of spectrum to continue normally.
