

Dear Sir/Madam:

I respectfully disagree with the chairman of the FCC supporting BPL (Broadband over Power Line) at this time.

Although BPL is a novel approach to internet access, I believe it is a ill-conceived idea and requires additional research in order to protect other users of the 2MHz to 30MHz spectrum. No NPRM (Notice of Proposed Rulemaking) should be implemented at this time. Additionally, I support the Comment submitted by The American Radio Relay League concerning Docket ET 03-104. I have reviewed their data and have found it to be accurate and complete. The proponents of BPL have not demonstrated that this technology would not violate the FCC rules on non-interference in this service. A more robust design approach to BPL must be created before proceeding.

Approval of ET 03-104 would be contrary to the best interest of the public and our nation at this time.
