

After reviewing documentation on the BPL proposal I have concluded that this will only lead to MUCH MORE interference with other services than we already have. The FCC has in the past had to step in to resolve Power line interference issues and I see NO REASON to willingly create more!! MUCH MORE research must be done to make this a viable service. It is much more necessary To resolve problems with the existing power grid than to create a new monster on an old system.
