

I support the Comment submitted by the American Radio Relay League concerning item ET 03-104. I do understand the great financial gain that could be obtained by commercially utilizing power lines for communication, however:

These types of cables were not designed for this application and there could be severe interference to licensed users of the 2-80 mhz. frequencies. These users including Amateur Radio Operators are a valuable non-centralized resource in times of distress.

In addition the FCC has promised to protect licensed users of the spectrum. I personally hold the FCC responsible to protect and reduce interference - not allow it to be further polluted. The FCC is the "EPA" of the frequencies. The EPA would not allow further water pollution for financial gain, neither should the FCC allow further spectrum pollution. Further research, development, and scientific testing of this concept is needed as required to implement it WITHOUT its spectrum pollution. Only then will it be acceptable and safe for the American People.
