

I support fully the well founded Comment submitted by The American Radio Relay League concerning Docket ET 03-104. I conclude the comments made by proponents of Broadband over Power Line (BPL) have little if any credible scientific data to support approval of this docket at this time. As an FCC licensed amateur radio operator I am concerned that BPL interference will make me less able or possibly totally unable to use HF radio frequencies both for hobby and emergency services uses. Imagine 9/11 with ham radio operators disabled by terrible noise on hf radios.

I feel further research and innovations in BPL will be needed to avoid the great risk this innovative technology will not cause irreparable interference to services licensed to operate in the 2 MHz - 80 MHz frequency range. Approval of ET 03-104 would violate the existing FCC rules on non-interference and would be contrary to the best interest of the public. thank you for your reconsideration.
