

I'm afraid the quick tests performed by representatives of the American Radio Relay League, while not definitive, have identified a clear possibility of rf leakage from BPL across the HF spectrum at levels that would severely impair the many licensed users of the spectrum.

I strongly urge that no "go-ahead" be given to any version of this technology without in-depth testing by a competent independent entity with no "axe to grind" on either side of the issue to evaluate the interference potential. Taking into account the fact that most users of HF communications depend on reception of relatively weak signals.
