

After 20 years in the communications field, I have chased many instances of RFI and I believe that this proposal is a "train wreck ready to happen". Unless the same rules that apply to cable TV transmission can be applied to BPL, this should not be granted. From a technical standpoint, if the power company could have a "closed system" (i.e. shielded from radiating RF) this would be a good idea, however based on what I've seen over my years dealing with power companies this will never happen.

Although the main interference would be in the HF spectrum, who know how it could affect the higher frequencies and the Public Safety and aeronautical services.

To me, this is a pollution of a natural resource of biblical proportion!
I would strongly recommend that the FCC deny this partition.
