The present FCC Part 15 limits for this technology already can result in substantial interference potential to amateur frequencies.

BPL systems that radiate on wide swaths of spectrum and that occupy entire neighborhoods have greater interference potential than localized systems, such as switching power supplies or electric motors.

The FCC has promised to protect licensed users of the spectrum. We must hold you to that promise.
