

Commissioners of the FCC:

RFI field studies by the ARRL have shown that BPL produces a tremendous amount of interference to users of the HF spectrum. Given that fact and the blackout of 2003 last week, perhaps it would be wise for the Commission to withhold its approval for deployment of BPL and allow the power companies to invest their limited capital and resources in modernizing the electrical grid. An unreliable electric grid does far more economic harm to our nation than does a lack of competition and choice in broadband providers.
