

I am very concerned that BPL will create unacceptable RFI issues for other services such as ham radio, land mobile, and Part 15 devices. Hams were forced to stop using spark gap transmitters decades ago because of the broadband interference they caused, and rightly so -- the costs (interference) was not worth the benefits (public safety aspects of ham radio, international ambassadorship, and other positives) EVEN THOUGH those benefits were and are significant. BPM *\*must\** be implemented in such a way to ensure there are no adverse affects on other services, but the current proposal does not do enough to ensure this is the case. It needs more careful thought.
