

As an electrical engineer and amateur radio operator of 45 years, I have serious concerns of the "rush to judgement" and the unbridled enthusiasm for Broadband over Power Line (BPL).

Preliminary studies indicate that serious interference will occur in the HF bands as a result of implementing BPL.

I am writing both from an amateur radio viewpoint and in support of the ARRL's Comment but I believe this potential interference will be viewed rather dimly by the maritime, aeronautical, military, Homeland Security and all other users of the HF spectrum.

Please resist industry pressures until comprehensive testing reveals whether the existing FCC rules on non-interference will be violated.
