

I believe that the support comments that the The American Radio Relay League submitted concerning Docket ET 03-104 are very well founded. I conclude the comments made by proponents of Broadband over Power Line (BPL) have little if any credible scientific data to support approval of this docket. Further research and innovations in BPL will is needed to avoid risk that this innovative technology presents in the form of irreparable interference to services licensed to operate in the 2 MHz - 80 MHz frequency range. I fully believe that the approval of ET 03-104 would violate the existing FCC rules on non-interference and would be contrary to the best interest of the general public.

I also would like to mention that the recent blackout seems to have been caused at least in part by non compliance with rules that the power companies themselves agreed upon. I question the ability of the power companies to properly administer a new technology given their inability to control something that they have specialized in for decades.
