

I hasten to point out that thousands of FCC licensed radio amateurs disagree with the intent of the FCC to permit Broadband over Powerline data transmission. It is certain that harmful interference will be generated by this transmission mode not only to licensed radio amateurs, but potentially to public safety and commercial broadcasters as well. The FCC has a blemished record in protecting licensed radio services from interference. Consider the 800MHz fiasco. The FCC should have protected public safety from the ESMR in-band interference instead of taking an "oblivious" position in the beginning. I believe in light of the clear evidence that BPL will harm existing licensed radio services, any support of this proposed mode is irresponsible and not in keeping with the "promoting safety of life and property" function of the FCC.
