On September 30, 2003, the Cellular Telecommunications & Internet Association (“CTIA”), represented by Diane Cornell, Vice President for Regulatory Policy, Rob Kubik, Manager, Spectrum and Regulatory Policy, Motorola, Neeti Tandon, AT&T Wireless Services, Inc., Dean Brenner, representing QUALCOMM, Inc., met with representatives from the Office of Engineering and Technology, including Ed Thomas, Chief, Julius Knapp, Deputy Chief, Jim Schlichting, Deputy Chief, Bruce Romano, Associate Chief, Legal, Alan Scrim, Chief, Policy and Rules Division, Ira Keltz, Deputy Chief, Policy and Rules Division, Jamison Prime, and Shameeka Hunt. The parties discussed the MSS reallocation proceeding, specifically the attached presentation. In addition, the CTIA representatives discussed the two additional charts to emphasize that at least 15 MHz separation is necessary between the mobile and base transmit PCS bands to prevent interference from occurring.
