

As one of the nation's more than 670,000 federally licensed radio amateurs, I support fully the well founded Comment submitted by The American Radio Relay League concerning Docket ET 03-104.

I conclude the comments made by proponents of Broadband over Power Line (BPL) have little if any credible scientific data to support approval of this docket at this time. Further research and innovations in BPL will be needed to avoid the great risk this innovative technology can cause to licensed radio stations. This technology causes irreparable interference to stations licensed to operate in the 2 MHz - 80 MHz frequency range.

Approval of ET 03-104 would violate the existing FCC rules on non-interference and would be contrary to the best interest of the public.
