Our community has a local LPFM community radio station, KPIE-LP in Dallas, Oregon. KPIE provides real local service to our community and takes an active part in our community by broadcasting events and news and programs that pertain to us.

I have been made aware of the contents of the MITRE report and although I do not understand all the technical data. I know that our local station is being severely interfered with by another station about 60 miles away in Portland on the same frequency that does NOT serve our community.

If the recommendations of the MITRE report were followed and Congress allowed the FCC to remove the third adjacent channel rule, then our local radio station could move to a clear frequency where we could hear them and not be competing with the Portland radio signal.

I therefore support the conclusions and recommendations in the MITRE Report and urge the Commission to recommend to Congress the removal of the third adjacent rule.
