Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is towards the administrative convenience of the Commission in entertaining the reply comments to the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, FCC 03-56, due October 24, 2003, so as to avoid any inadvertent mischaracterization of the record.

In its reply comments, Region 10 stated that based on the comments to the proceeding it had reconsidered two points it had made or suggested in its comments. As reconsidered in its reply comments, the points are: 1. That no underlay operations be permitted; and 2. That ITFS eligibility requirements remain unchanged irrespective of any restructuring of the ITFS spectrum.

Inasmuch as a few reply commenters addressed Region 10's comments, we are alerting Commission staff to Region 10's reconsidered comments by this separate communication that by its reply comments, Region 10 opposes underlay operations and opposes changing ITFS eligibility requirements.
