Dear Mr. Ball:

On behalf of Globalstar, L.P. (“GLP”), I am requesting a one week extension, until December 18, 2003, to respond to your letter request for additional information dated November 21, 2003.

As you may be aware, throughout November 2003, GLP has been involved in due diligence related to the sale of its assets to Thermo Capital Partners LLC, and financial reorganization under Chapter 11, as approved by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware on November 20, 2003. The final documents for this sale were still being reviewed and prepared up until the end of last week. This transaction has required substantial attention of both legal and engineering personnel.

Your request arrived during the middle of this due diligence process. But, the transaction documents are now substantially complete. A one-week extension would allow the company to devote the time necessary to review your questions internally and respond with the degree of specificity needed. Accordingly, we seek a one-week extension for GLP’s response until December 18, 2003.
