NOTICE OF EX PARTE PRESENTATION

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Friday, February 6, 2004, John B. Muleta, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, Bureau legal advisor Uzoma C. Onyeije, Deputy Bureau Chief Catherine W. Seidel, (participating via telephone), and Associate Bureau Chief David Furth, met with the undersigned, representing the Wireless Communications Association International, Inc. ("WCA"), regarding the *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* ("NPRM") in the referenced proceeding.

The participants discussed at length the proposal advanced by WCA, the National ITFS Association ("NIA") and Catholic Television Network ("CTN") for transitioning from the current bandplan to that proposed by WCA, NIA and CTN and the costs and benefits of using Commission-controlled competitive bidding mechanisms to provide industry newcomers with enhanced opportunities to consolidate channel holdings. WCA stressed that consolidation opportunities are currently available through secondary market transactions and that the major industry operators have not found the transaction costs associated with such transactions to be particularly onerous deterrents to consolidation. The substance of the positions expressed by WCA's representatives is reflected in the comments and reply comments submitted by WCA, NIA and CTN in response to the *NPRM*.
