

Broadband Over Power Line is an ill conceived proposal. I have been in the radio-electronics repair business since 1974 and have seen many interference problems with equipment that supposedly already meets Part 15 standards: "1) This device may not cause harmful interference. 2) This device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation." HAH! HAH!

I believe that Broadband Over Power Line will cause huge amounts of interference with consumer devices - especially those operating in the LF and HF spectrum and that legal/clean transmitters operating in these spectrums could likewise cause problems with the broadband communication devices. This is a "Pandora's Box" the FCC should not want to open.
