

I am registering my opposition to the authorization of Broadband over Power Lines (BPL) due to the fact that it would entail the use of radio frequency waves that have the capacity to cause interference with other forms of radio communications. I am particularly opposed to the authorization under Part 15 as this would create a totally unregulated entity that would be difficult at best, and more than likely impossible to police for violations by both provider and user.

At the very least, if the Commission believes it is in the public interest and therefore necessary to provide some form of authorization for BPL, it should be as a fully regulated entity with an assigned frequency, restrictions on the power levels used, and subject to regular monitoring by the Commission Staff for non-interference with any other radio spectrum user or receiver.
