

I would like to express my concern about BPL and its proven interference with HF communications. As a ham radio operator (KC9CZJ) and a consumer of international news via "shortwave" radio, I am concerned that BPL will interfere with such communications enough to render both unusable. I don't know whether this is tantamount to infringement of freedom of speech or freedom of the press, but BPL will negatively affect me and others like me. Those who the industry claim will benefit most from BPL (rural customers) already have other means available, such as DSL.
