


As Chief of the Bedford Police Department, I have dedicated my life to serving my community. The Bedford Police Department, comprised of 26 sworn officers, serves more than 12,000 people on a daily basis. Celebrating its 275th anniversary, Bedford continues to be a clean, safe, and well-rounded suburban town with much to offer. My department believes Bedford residents deserve guaranteed protection in the most efficient and comprehensive manner as possible.

In order to provide consistent service to our citizens, all emergency operations must run smoothly. Due to the need for precision in law enforcement and rescue missions, it is deeply disconcerting to hear some departments throughout the United States have been struggling with a communications problem that inhibits officers from hearing and communicating with each other on their mobile radios.

First responders have come together to champion a comprehensive solution called The Consensus Plan and the Bedford PD would like to add our support. Hundreds of locations are affected by interference throughout the United States every year and it is frightening to think lives could be lost because of this communications problem, a problem that can be solved. The fully funded Plan will eliminate interference while providing public safety with necessary additional bandwidth for future multi-jurisdictional capabilities. The Consensus Plan is the solution public safety needs.

Accept the Consensus Plan immediately and help provide public safety organizations with reliable communications tools to protect our citizens.
