

I hear you have unanimously approved a Notice of Proposed Rule Making (NPRM) to deploy Broadband over Power Line (BPL). I am extremely upset about the overall degradation to HF and VHF frequencies that will result; Many homeland security agencies such as FEMA and local fire and police, as well as medical, rescue, and ham/shortwave users will be SEVERELY impacted. It is not possible to put in place devices to adequately minimize the impact to all people. By Federal law the FCC is mandated to protect, not degrade, these frequencies.
