

I am opposed to Broadband over Powerline (BPL). I believe it would cause unprecedented electrical interference to a variety of legal, lawful (and in some cases, licensed by the FCC) RF spectrum users. Once BPL is online, the signal would be present -- even if the utility that owns the offending power line does not have a single customer in the area!!! So, even without providing service to anyone, the utility would be causing interference to everyone nearby. At a time when the entire country is becoming wired for internet access (using existing systems), there has been no demonstration that this service is even required.
