

I am concerned about the implications of BPL to licensed radio users. The possibilities for interference and conflict are enormous when communications are carried over such an open system as power lines (which were never designed for this purpose). Clearly there has not been enough study to justify BPL activity.

I support proposal 03-104 in that it reaffirms that licensed services must be protected from harmful interference and are not required to protect BPL systems. Although this proposal is aimed in the right direction, it does not go far enough to adequately protect licensed radio activity. I encourage the FCC not to give into the BPL lobby without conducting significantly more research into the interference potential.
