

Having listened to the type of interference that BPL can produce on the High Frequency bands, I am appalled at the idea of the FCC allowing this to become a reality. Especially the fact that the 5Mhz (60 meter band cannot be prevented from being harmed by this interference when that band was supposedly created to provide for emergency communications in time of disasters both natural and otherwise.

Considering also that 4 to 5 watts of output power from a licensed amateur transmitter can wipe out BPL, The FCC is potentially creating a public relations disaster of untold magnitude for both the power industry as well as the licensed services that operate in the 2 to 30 Mhz spectrum.

I must respectfully urge the FCC to abandon this proposal of allowing Broadband over Power line from becoming a reality.
