

As a liscensed radio amateur, I would like to express my concerns over the NPRM for access BPL. The current BPL technology has been proven, with many documentd cases, to cause harmful interference to the HF radio amateur frequencies. If allowed to be implemented, BPL would jeopardize the ability for liscensed radio amateur's to use these frequecies. Current filter technology is not adequate to eliminate BPL interference to the radio amateur spectrum.

The fact that several developed nations, most notably Japan, have not deployed a BPL system, due to harmful interference, is credence enough to give us reason to be highly concerned over this technology. BPL in it's current state, should not be implemented due to the harmful interference it causes to other liscensed radio spectrum users.
