

Broadband internet over the PowerLine is a concept that should be denied. In the event that the Federal Communications Commission allows this type service under Part 15, then the purveyors of this type service should be required to submit ACCURATE test data, showing levels of radiation on ALL frequencies throughout the electromagnetic spectrum when their systems are utilized. Without COMPLETE, preliminary test data, this service should NOT be allowed to function.

Part 15 allows maximum radiation levels and methods for suppression of interference when it appears, even if the levels are within the Part 15 limits. NONE of the BPL applicants has filed and/or shown that their equipment, as proposed, would fit Part 15 limitations and suppression requirements.

Please consider all the ramifications of interference to low-signal communications that WILL occur if BPL is allowed to function WITHOUT meeting Part 15 limitations and suppression requirements.
