

The proposals for allowing Broadband over Power lines is too leniant. If this technology is allowed to exist it must include stringent requirements for mitigating interferences issues. These would include:

- 1) 24/7 access to power company interference resolution departments
- 2) immediate response to complaints
- 3) forced shutdown of the BPL provider if the interference cannot be resolved.
- 4) These rules need to be enforcable and have meaningful "teeth".

The FCC has a mandate that the LICENSED users of a spectrum not be adversely affected by UNLICENSED users. These guidelines will insure the integrity of our HF Radio Spectrum. Thank you
