

Comments on ET Docket No. 04-37

As a licensed radio ham, K2GLS, I have listened to the interference from several BPL field trial systems, and find the interference does make it difficult to communicate with other hams. Since these field trial systems do not have the level of traffic that a fully occupied system will have, the interference can only get worse. I urge the commission to reconsider the proposed rules in ET Docket 04-37 to protect the high frequency bands used by commercial, emergency, systems, as well as ham radio. Our local fire, police and first aid squads all use radios in the 35 to 45 MHz band, and the interference from BPL is present in this band as well as the lower HF bands.
