

Please reconsider the deployment of BPL. I have witnessed the Harmful Interference in Fuquay Varina, NC, and submitted complaints to Progress Energy. They have not stopped their interference despite their violation of Part 15 regulations.

I agree with the findings of the ARRL and point out that the measurements made by the NTIA support their concerns. If BPL is deployed in a wide area, there will be significant, harmful interference to Amateur Radio and other licensed services. BPL is not an efficient means of delivering Broadband; DSL, Cable, and WiMax are good alternatives and do not interfere.
