

As a long-time Amateur Radio Operator, I am deeply concerned with the FCC's current position supporting deployment of BPL. It does not appear that sufficient technology or regulation is in place to prevent widespread interference by BPL networks with licensed RF operations, especially Amateur Radio. BPL should not be deployed until it is clearly demonstrated that the technology is robust enough to coexist without interfering with licensed operations and until the regulations are strong enough to ensure interference is immediately corrected if and when it occurs.
