

Concerning maintaining existing Part 15 limits. The NTIA report states that interference has been underestimated. Their data indicates the very strong interference is present. The statement understates the data. It appears that if the data presented in general meets part 15, then limits set for BPL must be much lower.

Concerning BPL systems shall employ interference reduction techniques. Progress Energy Corp has declared they have reduced interference to their satisfaction while the top end of the 20 meter amateur band is covered up.
