

In reference to NPRM on BPL, ET Docket No. 03-104, please accept my comments herein.

The NPRM proposes that BPL operators must reduce power, change frequency or shut down their systems by remote control. I am concerned that this requirement will not be met by proposed BPL Operators while adversely interfering with critical Amateur communications.

Although I would prefer to not have to deal with BPL interference, I submit other concerns if BPL does become lawful: (1) The BPL database must be current and accessible to citizens, (2) interference mitigation must be practiced aggressively by qualified engineers only and (3) BPL operators must market their systems so not to mislead consumers.
