

Since the Phase 1 NTIA study has shown that, even at current Part 15 power levels, Access BPL will cause significant interference to licensed users of HF frequencies, I am against any changes to Part 15 that would increase the power levels used in BPL systems. I think a "go slow" approach to encouraging BPL deployment should be taken, at least until Phase 2 of the NTIA study is complete and we can see their analysis of potential problems with skywave propagation of BPL signals.

Since increased access to broadband is an important national goal, I favor any action the FCC can take to encourage increased DSL, cable, and Wi-Fi broadband access.
