I am opposed to the authorization of the deployment of BPL as proposed in the current NPRM. I've personally traveled to a BPL test site in PA and tuned the 2-30 Mhz radio spectrum in order to find out for myself, in qualitative terms, the level of interference BPL causes to the multitude of current users of that spectrum space. Which includes me as an Amateur Extra licensee.

Without belaboring the matter it only took minutes of tuning and listening to come to the conclusion that BPL can and will destroy most if not all other communications across that span of spectrum space wherever it is deployed.

BPL as proposed in this NPRM is clearly the wrong broadband access technology in the wrong slice of the electromagnetic spectrum.

I urge the Commission to heed the recommendations of NTIA Report 04-413 of 04/27/04.
