

I would like to express my concern over every aspect of BPL emissions and their possible or likely interference with radio amateur and AM radio receptions. Power lines are ubiquitous. Our limited frequency allocations are subject to many forms of interference which are hard to control as it is.

Unless BPL is tightly regulated and emission quantity enforced, radio amateur communications could become extremely difficult, if not impossible, in, or near, BPL 'hot' zones, rendering our expensive equipment, and our hard work in obtaining licenses, obsolete.
