I am a shortwave radio broadcast listener. I have reviewed the FCC's Notice of Proposed Rule Making concerning broadband over power lines.

I live near power company transmission lines, which at present do not interfere with the quality of my listening to shortwave radio programs. However, I am concerned that should interference occur with broadband over power lines, the practical use of shortwave broadcasting in the United States will be severely affected. Before proceeding with this new technology I urge you to conduct small area research studies to find out the impact of this data transmission system on the shortwave and amateur radio spectrum.
