Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 2, 2004 and on behalf of Ad Hoc Alliance, I had separate meetings with Ms. Sheryl Wilkerson, Legal Advisor to Chairman Powell. During these meetings we discussed Ad Hoc's concerns regarding the proposed relocation site for MDS 1 & 2. Ad Hoc expressed its objection to the proposed reduction of its members' spectrum, which runs counter to the Commission's promise to provide spectrum comparable to what we currently have. The proposed new location has inferior propagation characteristics and, as a result, requires 35% to 50% more cells to provide the same level of service that could be provided at the present location.

Ad Hoc also stated its strong objection to the staff's proposal to auction a portion of the MMDS band.
