

I am NOT in favor of the deployment of BPL because:

1. It will degrade radio communications, military, commercial and amateur. With Homeland Security being so important, is it wise to risk degradation of our communications capability?
2. It will interfere with shortwave broadcast reception, violating ITU regulations, at a time when the U.S. has already offended much of the rest of the world.
3. It is unneeded. Other technology exists to do the job without interference to other services, e.g. DSL, cable modems and WiFi.

I live in a county with a population of less than 10,000 people, ten miles from a city of less than 3000. I have a choice of WiFi or DSL. If it can be done here, broadband Internet service can be made available anywhere, without BPL.
