

As a resident who makes use of off-air reception of amateur radio signals, television, and AM/FM radio I am very concerned about the prospect of BPL (broadband over power line). The radiation limits proposed by the FCC would cause interference levels in excess of 20 db greater than desired received signals at my location. There are many alternatives to BPL that are currently under-utilized and far more suitable as a means of providing broadband data service, both in the licensed and unlicensed ISM bands. I urge the FCC to avoid making a serious mistake with regard to spectrum pollution. If this service is authorized it will severely disrupt many types of existing communication as we know it.
