

I am commenting on the BPL proposal and how detrimental it will be to Amateur Radio operators around the world. The additional noise that is intentionally created is both illegal and immoral. Illegal due to the interference that will be created in the short wave bands and immoral because of the intentional, non-compromising attitude the proponents of this appear to have.

With the increased interest in low power operation in the amateur service, partly to alleviate some of the band crowding, with BPL, only high powered stations with large antennas will be able to communicate, a truly sad testimonial to 'low impact' spectrum users.
