On Friday June 11, 2004, Nextel Communications, Inc. ("Nextel") participated via conference call with staff of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau ("Bureau") regarding the Commission's above-referenced proceeding on public safety communications in the 800 MHz band. Attending on behalf of Nextel were Lawrence Krevor, Nextel's Vice President – Government Affairs; Geoff Stearn, Nextel's Vice President – Spectrum Resources; Dave Maples, Nextel's Senior RF Operations Manager; and the undersigned. Attending on behalf of the Bureau were Aaron Goldberger, Legal Advisor and Michael Wilhelm, Acting Deputy Chief (Legal), Public Safety & Critical Infrastructure Division.

The parties discussed Nextel's June 9, 2004 *ex parte* letter where Nextel described its offer to enhance the Consensus Plan by contributing an additional 2 MHz of 800 MHz spectrum to public safety communications.
