On June 10, 2004, Gerald M. Knoblach and Eric Schimmel of Space Data Corporation ("Space Data") and Jennifer L. Kostyu and the undersigned of Morrison & Foerster LLP on behalf of Space Data, met with Kathy Harris, Richard Arsenault, Jay Jackson and Moslem Sawez of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, Mobility Division, and Julius Knapp, Salomon Satche and Ira Keltz of the Office of Engineering and Technology to discuss the above-referenced proceeding. Space Data noted that the air-to-ground ("ATG") market does not offer consumer choice and as a result, ATG service is not competitively priced, not universally available to air travelers and not technically advanced. Space Data discussed its proposal for introducing consumer choice into the ATG market that was set forth in Space Data's reply comments in this proceeding. Space Data otherwise relied upon the attached presentation during the meeting.
