On behalf of AIRPEAK Communications, LLC ("AIRPEAK") and Airtel Wireless Services, LLC ("Airtel") (collectively "Companies") and in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b), undersigned counsel hereby submits the instant notice of an *ex parte* presentation.

On June 16, 2004, Elizabeth R. Sachs, counsel for the Companies, met with Michael Wilhelm, Roberto Mussenden and Brian Marengo, all of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, to discuss issues relating to implementation of the 800 MHz "Consensus Plan," consistent with the Companies' earlier-filed Comments in this proceeding. In particular, the parties discussed in what segment of the 800 MHz band the Companies' digital Harmony systems should operate in the event of rebanding, issues relating to the rebanding process itself, and the quantification of EA and site-specific spectrum positions for purposes of rebanding.
